Who Should Go?

This camp is designed for high school students who are preparing for a future health care career. Participants must have a minimum 3.0 GPA in order to apply.

What is it?

The Health Career Exploration Camp is 3-days of activities designed to help students prepare to pursue a health care career. High school students, ages sophomores through seniors, are invited to attend. You will attend workshops, lectures and panel discussions that will showcase health care careers. Opportunities to interact with health care professionals, learn health care skills, and conduct science experiments will be provided.

Participants will interact with other students from all across the state who are also interested in health care. Social activities are planned, including team building events, recreational activities, and an outdoor dinner and dance.

As a participant, you will get to experience college life first-hand as you spend the 3-days living and learning at Southern Utah University.

Which Track Do I Pick?

We provide two tracks at our camp, Track 1 and Track 2. Participants can choose either track, depending on their interests. Both tracks provide exciting, hands-on workshops that teach a wide range of health care skills. Because we provide two tracks, individuals have the opportunity to attend our summer camp for two years. If you participated in one of the tracks previously, be sure to choose the other one for new workshops.
