Goals:

- Identify areas for improvement in patient care and safety
- Improve understanding of factors that impact patient care
- Involve housestaff in ongoing systems improvement and obtain their input in these projects
- Educate housestaff in practice-based learning and improvement
- Educate housestaff in systems-based practice
- Develop action plans for systems improvement and provide follow-up

Learning Objectives:

By the end of the M&M conference, participants will have increased:

- Knowledge of practice-based learning and improvement including the ability to implement change with the goal of practice improvement
- Knowledge of system-based practice including the ability to participate in identifying system errors and implementing potential solutions.
- Familiarity with ongoing patient safety and quality improvement (QI) initiatives at LPCH
- Ability to identify patient safety and QI opportunities in case presentations and patient care

- Update on actions that have been implemented due to this case (5 min, QI resident)
