2009 CAMPUS STATEMENT

The College of Technology at Alfred (“Alfred State College”) had its beginning as a State School of Agriculture in 1908 when it was created by an act of State Legislature. An important milestone in the history of the College occurred in 1948 when it was incorporated into the newly organized State University of New York system. In 1951, the College was authorized by SUNY to award the degree of Associate in Applied Science, the Associates in Sciences and Associates in Arts degrees were authorized in 1967, and an Associate in Occupational Studies was approved in 1973. Bachelor degrees were added to the College’s offerings in 1991. Today, the College has 52 associate degrees, 17 bachelor degrees, and three certificate programs. The College enrolls approximately 3,500 students and has residential facilities for more than 2,500 students.

The College’s 650-acre main campus is located in the village of Alfred, New York, a vibrant community with a population of approximately 2,000 residents and nearly 6,000 students enrolled in the village’s three colleges. The campus infrastructure, facilities and grounds provide an outstanding learning environment. The College offers wireless network and Internet access across the entire campus.

Recent capital improvements include a completed multi-million dollar rehabilitation of the Engineering Technology Building; the renovation of the Central Dining Hall, including a new student gathering space, rehabilitation/upgrade of the athletic facility (new field and track enlargement). Also newly constructed is a 150-bed townhouse complex. The project provides apartment-style residency and enhanced parking for students. Regular on-going maintenance includes roof replacement on various buildings, concrete and black-top repair, and classroom upgrades. In addition, a variety of minor rehab projects are nearing completion in the library, EJ Brown and several residence halls. Capital improvements are underway for critical maintenance and renovation to Allied Health, Central Dining Hall – Phase II, including a new state of the art servery and to the campus water infrastructure. A plan to update the residence halls is in development. The new color schemes and décor will provide a more home-like atmosphere and a sense of community for our residents.

A major initiative currently in the planning stages involves the College’s century-long role in agriculture education and will include the construction of an agriculture complex of buildings known as COSA (The Center for Organic and Sustainable Agriculture). As the College embarks upon its centennial, it is positioned to reform and expand its agriculture programs in a way that will create a unique educational niche within SUNY and the nation.

In addition, our new Institute for Sustainability will promote the advancement of sustainability at Alfred State College and Western New York through delivery of training programs, as well as public outreach and partnerships.

The Student Leadership Center is another major initiative that is in the planning stages. It will be located at the center of the campus and will be the premier place for students to gather between classes and throughout the day in a uniquely designed space. It will be the hub of student engagement and involvement that is energized and exciting and will be known for years as the place where student leaders and world citizens are made.
