

#### Dear Applicant:

Thank you for your interest in the **UB STARS**, the University at Buffalo **ST**udent **A**dmissions **Recruitment Specialists!** In this packet, you will learn everything from what it means to be a UB STAR to how to apply. Please be sure to look over all the information, and especially keep in mind the dates noted on the attached timeline so that your application is in on time!

#### Who we are:

The UB STARS are a dynamic group of undergraduates that help recruit prospective students to UB. The STARS are one of three branches of the Office of Admission's Student Recruiter Unit, acting at all times to promote the following goal:

# \*TO PROVIDE EVERY PROSPECTIVE STUDENT WITH AN OPPORTUNITY TO CONNECT WITH A CURRENT STUDENT\*

#### What that means:

As a member of the UB STARS, students assist us here in Admissions in a very important way. STARS are UB *students*, and as such have a different perspective than that of an admissions counselor to provide to families about what life is like here at the University at Buffalo. In furtherance of our goal to provide prospective students with a current one, we keep our STARS busy doing the following activities:

- STARS staff the Admissions screen name, UBADMIT, from the hours of 9-5. Prospective students and their parents can instant message a STAR to ask questions about everything from life at UB, being a college student, and how and when to apply. STARS are trained to be able to answer admissions specific questions, but most importantly they provide the student with the reality of being a UB student.
- STARS assist us at many different Admissions events, most importantly Open House. We want those interested in UB to hear *from a student* about what it means *to be* a student. This is a perspective an admissions counselor cannot give! That is where the STARS come in.
- STARS visit their high schools to make a presentation about UB and all it has to offer. High schoolers who hear a presentation from not only a student at UB, but one who comes from the same place and who they maybe even know are more inclined to feel a connection with us and consider applying and enrolling.

#### Why become a STAR?

- The STARS are a close knit group of students, united in the fact that they are a part of a very selective group. You will meet some great people you might not have otherwise ever crossed paths with. We have all types of majors, interests, personalities, and ideas- STARS are a representative sample showcasing all of the different forms of diversity at UB!
- The STARS are special, and therefore they attract attention from important faculty members and UB staff. You will make invaluable connections that can only help you in your future, both during and after your time at UB. Having STARS on your resume will only improve your marketability in the job and educational market.
- STARS must be personable, as they are often the one and only face a prospective family will see that connects them to the University. It is important that the one person a family connects with represents UB in the most positive light possible! Spending some time in STARS will give you public speaking experience, strengthen your ability to think quickly and confidently when speaking with people you must make a good impression on, and help you develop sophisticated communication skills. The qualities nurtured as a STAR will help you excel in school and make you a competitive force in whatever career you choose to pursue after your time at UB.
- If you really love UB, meeting new people, and helping others, than what could be more rewarding than helping a potential UB student make one of the most important decision in their lives? The STARS are always telling me how much fun they had meeting someone new, and how great it was to know that they *came to UB because of them!* They have fun, develop connections and communication skills, meet great people and help others out by just being themselves and loving UB.
- If you are interested in giving *tours* to prospective students, becoming a STAR is the avenue to do so. The tour guides that work for our office are almost all STARS, and we DO NOT allow any students who are NOT members of STARS or our other student group, the UB TeleTeam, to become tour guides. Tour guides have opportunities beyond STARS to improve their public speaking skills, learn more about UB, make connections and meet new people. But you can't be a tour guide unless you join STARS first!



#### Ok, sounds good to me! What do I do now?

Membership in STARS is competitive. We are looking for enthusiastic, dedicated students who love UB and want to share that excitement with interested students. Involvement in other activities is not as important as showing us that your personality will make a lasting, positive impression on students and parents who are considering making a big choice- the choice to join our UB community for one of the most important academic and personal experiences of their lives. To be eligible you must:

- 1. Fill out the attached application by **March 4**, including one recommendation with the form provided;
- 2. Have at least a **2.5 cumulative grade point average** at the time of application;
- 3. Be at least a second-semester freshman who has completed 1 full semester at UB;
- 4. Be available one Saturday per semester to help with our Visit UB program, help us at Fall and Spring Open House, attend monthly meetings, and commit to one office hour per week. The time commitment is small, but very important! We need responsible students we can depend on;
- 5. Have a sincere desire to represent and promote UB in an enthusiastic manner and have a strong sense of pride in the University;
- 6. Have the ability to work well with others, adapt to sometimes difficult situations, and possess effective communication skills.

If we feel you have the qualities we are looking for, we will contact you for an in-person interview before selecting our STARS for 2011-2012.
