SCSPA will offer one \$500 scholarship, sponsored by Jostens Yearbook Company, to a graduating high school senior who shows scholarship in yearbook journalism and who plans to attend the University of South Carolina's main campus in Columbia in the fall of 2015.

AWARD

The \$500 scholarship will be awarded in two stipends: \$250 during the first semester and \$250 in the second semester, provided the first semester work has been completed in good standing (minimum 3.0 GPR).

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must be a graduating senior who is definitely planning to attend the University of South Carolina in Columbia in 2014-2015.

The applicant may be the same student nominated for the SCSPA Journalist-of-the-Year Award. The scholarship recipients and the Journalist of the Year are selected by different committees.

REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must:

- be a student member of SCSPA
- have worked on the school's yearbook for at least two years, or have taken a Journalism I class and worked on the yearbook one year
- mail a complete application that includes
 - a copy of their high school transcript
 - two letters of recommendation, which may be from advisers, teachers, principals, parents or yearbook reps
 - a 350 word personal essay showing how working on the yearbook has affected their high school career and how it will make them a better student, person and citizen
