Parking Information

Parking is available on campus at visitor meters located in the Bull Street Garage - on the corner of Bull and Blossom Streets (on the bottom floor, take ticket at entry and pay clerk \$1/ hour, as you exit) and in the Pendleton Street Garage - on the corner of Pickens and Pendleton Streets (cost is 50 cents/hour - quarters only).

Metered parking is available on the street, but spaces are difficult to find and there will not be sufficient time to allow you to feed the meter during the meeting.
