The collection consists of Adobe's applications (e.g., [Photoshop](#), [Acrobat](#), [InDesign](#)), that are used to design web pages and web sites for individuals and organizations.

Describe how this initiative relates to the University's Strategic Plan.

This initiative would assist in the creation of a larger pool of expertise in the areas of web page design and web site development within our community. Given the role of web pages and web sites in the generation, transmittal, and processing of information this initiative will do much to enhance the brand, currency in the use of technology, and competitiveness of our region.
