Project Title: *GroupSystems* Collaboration and Negotiations software

Describe the project: *GroupSystems* software facilitates meetings by providing anonymity to group decision tasks such as ranking, voting, prioritizing of objectives, brainstorming, negotiation, and other features.

Describe how this initiative relates to the University's Strategic Plan.

GroupSystems can facilitate effective faculty, administrative, and organizational meetings, and students can be trained to use this state-of-the-art technology. The implementation of this technology will add to the experiential learning opportunities of students and position the university as a negotiation and decision support resource.
