

The Belinda Villarreal-Nelson Memorial Scholarship

The Belinda Villarreal-Nelson Memorial Scholarship was established in 2006 by Major Rafael Villarreal, USAF (Ret.) and his wife, Maria Luisa Villarreal, in honor of their late daughter, Belinda Villarreal-Nelson who taught English and speech for 10 years at Crockett High School in Austin, Texas.

To be eligible for this scholarship you must meet the following requirements:

- Must be interested in becoming an educator to diverse student populations in one of the following areas: English, mathematics, science, bilingual education or special education.
- Be enrolled at UTSA as an undergraduate or as a post baccalaureate student seeking teacher certification at the undergraduate level.
- Must be enrolled as a full-time student (minimum of 12 credit hours). *This requirement can be waived if the student receives the award during the student teaching semester or if completing the last semester of required coursework.*
- Must demonstrate the need for financial assistance as determined by UTSA's Office of Student Financial Aid*.
- All things being equal, special consideration will be given to applicants with extreme financial need or from traditionally underrepresented populations in their field of study.

****The UTSA Financial Aid Office will determine your financial need for this scholarship based on a completed FAFSA. FAFSA applications for the 2011-12 academic year can be submitted starting January 1, 2011. If you have not submitted a FAFSA for 2011-12 please do so as early as possible.**
