Re-certification

Current RFES users whose certification has expired, will be notified upon log in to the RFES. Users will then be prompted to take the certification online.

- The online certification is not a timed training
- Certification training time ranges between 1 to 2 hours – Note: User must be prepared to devote time necessary as system will not save progress!





- The training will consist of 5 modules: which includes:
  - Introduction
  - Assessing for Acanthosis Nigricans
  - Conducting Heights and Weights
  - Blood Pressure Measures in Children
  - Reporting and Referral Process





- At the beginning of each module, will be given the module objectives
- At the end of each module, requires to answer a few questions before moving on to the next module
- If the response is incorrect, it will be given a quick review and will have an opportunity to answer the question correctly
