We are very pleased that you have chosen to make an expense-paid visit to the University of Utah's campus to evaluate our academic and athletics programs.

Please find enclosed the NCAA's list of banned substances and a copy of the University of Utah's graduation rates for your review. The NCAA requires institutions to send you this important information in the hope that it will assist you in selecting an institution and preparing for college.

We would also like to take this opportunity to inform you that NCAA rules only allow you to take a maximum of **five** expense-paid visits to Divisions I or II NCAA member institutions, with no more than one visit to any single institution. NCAA rules further require that your visit shall not exceed 48 hours, and that meals and entertainment may only be provided to you, your parents, and/or your spouse. Although it is permissible for the University to pay for your transportation expenses to campus and back home we may not pay for your parents, legal guardian or spouse's travel expenses.

In addition, you should be aware that NCAA rules limit the number of telephone calls, evaluations, and off-campus contacts that any coach may have with you or your parents.
