#### **IMPORTANT VERIFICATION INFORMATION FOR 2013-2014**

On July 12, 2012 the Department of Education published changes to the verification selection and documents requirement process. The Processing Center will use verification tracking flags to place you (and/or parent or spouse), selected for verification, into one of the five verification tracking groups. You, and/or your parents or spouse must verify all information based on the tracking group to which you are assigned. This information can be located on the last page of your 2013-2014 ISIR.
