## Information on the 3/2 program:

- A five-year coordinated bachelor's and master's programs, commonly referred to as the 3-2 program, is one of the opportunities available to students in engineering, biology, and chemistry.
- Once admitted to the 3-2 program, students are permitted to take courses for graduate credit in their senior year and, if necessary, undergraduate courses in their fifth year.
- No course may count toward both the baccalaureate degree and toward the master's degree. Both
  degrees are awarded at the end of the fifth year although often students finish and may be awarded
  the bachelor's degree earlier.
- Students in the fifth year receive full tuition remission for all courses, for which they are expected to work nine hours per week for the department.

## Instructions for Admission to the BS/MS Program

Applicants for admission to the combined undergraduate and graduate degree program are required to:

- Be current Bucknell University students in good standing with a minimum GPA of 3.0
- Complete the application for admission to the BS/MS program with appropriate signatures
- Submit two letters of recommendation
- Submit a personal statement outlining your area of interest
- Complete and submit all above required information by February 1 of their junior year.
