★ REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

Ticket sales for Senior Week 2009 will be held **Monday, April 13 – Friday, April 24** in the Rotunda against the Media Wall closest to Salmanson from 10 a.m. until 2 p.m. and on Tuesday April 14th, Wednesday April 15th, April Tuesday 21st, and April Wednesday 22nd from 5 p.m. until 7 p.m. Please make all checks payable to Bryant University and memo Senior Week 2009.

★ DEADLINE FOR ALL TICKET PURCHASES IS FRIDAY APRIL 24TH.

It is strongly recommended that you buy your tickets early! All registration forms (including payment) must be received by the deadline in order to purchase tickets to this year's events. The ticket price includes food at all events, transportation, and entertainment. Please note that the price of alcohol is not included in your registration fee, although some complimentary beverages are noted in the event descriptions. There will be **NO REFUNDS** or transfers on any tickets or packages purchased. Please plan accordingly. Any changes must be made during ticket sales, not after (including Senior Ball tables). Exceptions must come forth to the Senior Class co-chairs and the advisors who will make a decision under their discretion.

★ TRANSPORTATION:

In an effort to provide a safe evening for everyone attending the events, transportation will be provided for all off campus events. All students are **required to take the buses** provided for Waterplace and the Senior Ball events. Students who do not take the provided transportation will not be admitted to the events, even if you have already registered. In addition, there will be no refunds for failure to arrive at the buses at the time of departure (buses will leave promptly at the times indicated in this packet and will not wait). **There is absolutely NO ALCOHOL allowed on the buses.** If any student is found bringing alcohol onto a bus or to any Senior Week event, they will be subject to loss of Senior Week privileges and potential disciplinary action.

★ IDENTIFICATION:

You must provide **TWO** forms of identification at all Senior Week events. Your Bryant ID should be with you at all times during the week's events as well as a state issued picture ID (i.e. a driver's license). All guests must also provide a state issued picture ID.

★ GUESTS:

Any student, who is NOT a graduating senior of May or December 2009, or December 2008, is considered a guest, even if he or she is a Bryant University student. Guests must be registered for the events by the deadline and will not be able to pay at the time of the event. Please note the price differences between students and guests; because the purpose of Senior Week is to provide graduates the ability to celebrate their success, the package deal only applies to members of the Class of 2009. **Guests are only eligible to attend Senior Ball and the After Party BBQ.**

If your guest plans to stay on campus, please note that all campus guest policies are still in effect throughout the week, so please remember to follow proper guest procedures (outlined in the Student Handbook). Students are allowed one guest per person, who must be registered through the Department of Public Safety. You can do this through their website at web.bryant.edu/~dps. Please remember that you are also responsible for your guest at all times during the week. Non-senior Bryant students staying on campus as Senior Ball dates should plan to make arrangements with the Office of Residence Life.

★ TUXEDOS:

Waldorf Tuxedo is offering a complete gentlemen's tuxedo rental for only \$45 to any student attending the Senior Ball. That's a \$40 discount! This includes a classic black tuxedo coat (up to four different tuxedo styles) and trouser, shirt with studs and cuff links, a choice of tie and vest or cummerbund, and suspenders. This DOES NOT include shoes, which are an additional \$10. Designer tuxedos are also available for \$60 and up, plus the \$40 discount. Waldorf will be delivering the tuxedos to the Bryant Center Patio on Wednesday, May 13th from 11:00 a.m. – 1:00 p.m. Tuxedo return will be on Friday, May 15th from 11:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. at the Bryant Center. In the case of inclement weather, pick-up and distribution will occur inside the Bryant Center.
