The National Student Loan Data System (NSLDS) indicates that you received an overpayment of federal grant money. The U.S. Department of Education notified you of this problem in the Comments section of your Student Aid Report, which you can view at www.fafsa.ed.gov.

You must repay federal grant money that you were not entitled to receive. You are not eligible for financial aid until you resolve your overpayment. Your eligibility for financial aid can be restored if you can **PROVIDE DOCUMENTATION FROM YOUR PAST SCHOOL** that you have resolved your overpayment.

1. Which grant needs to be repaid?

- You can view the status of your federal grants by going to the NSLDS Student Access website at www.nsls.ed.gov.
- Click the Financial Aid Review button, and log on using your Social Security Number, the first two letters of your last name, your date of birth, and your FAFSA PIN.

2. How can you document that you have resolved the overpayment?

- Attach a statement on letterhead from your past school that identifies the grant that was overpaid, the overpayment amount, and the date you made the required repayment.

— OR —

- Ask financial aid staff at your past school to verify that you have resolved your overpayment by providing the following information.
