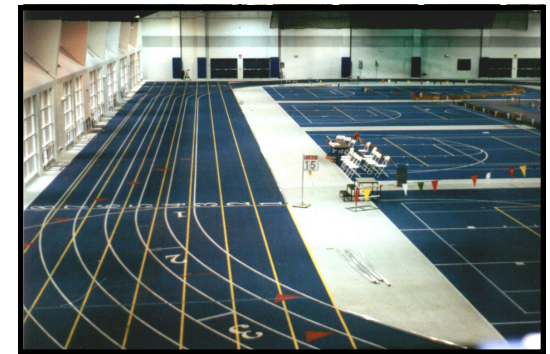

VEALE CENTER NATATORIUM:

Newly renovated and enlarged in spring 2001, the natatorium features both swimming and diving areas.

Completed in 1998, The Veale Center includes a 200 meter indoor track, four courts which can be set up for basketball, tennis and volleyball, a batting cage and both of CASE's indoor swimming pools. The Veale Center may be one of the finest indoor sports and recreation facilities in Northeastern Ohio.

Fee:

\$125.00/week includes use of facilities (gymnasium/athletic field/pool). A \$50.00/week deposit is due upon registration. The remaining balance for each week registered is due by June 1st.

What To Bring?

Every camper should bring a swim suit and towel, tennis shoes, athletic clothing, sun screen and a bagged lunch with drink. CASE camp will supply all athletic equipment needed except for baseball/softball gloves.

Camp will begin at 9:00 am and will end at 3:00 pm Monday through Friday. **Early Drop Off (as early as 7:00 am) and late pick up (as late as 6:00 pm) are available at an additional fee of \$3.00 / hour.**
