National Chemistry Week Mini-Grant Application

The proposed project should address one or more of the following goals using this year's NCW theme:

- Increase the public appreciation of chemistry
- Increase interest of young people in chemistry
- Generate enthusiasm for the future of chemistry
- Provide for pre-college teacher training

Monies received may be used for the purchase of supplies, chemicals, equipment, ACS-produced educational/promotional materials. Monies received may *not* be used for honoraria, stipends, wages, salaries, or travel expenses.

Proposal Criteria

Proposal should be no longer than one page and include no more than one attachment.

Project Rationale	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• In what way does the project involve the community?• How is the NCW theme addressed?
Target Audience	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Who is your target audience? Provide as much information as possible.
Project Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• What will occur during the course of the project?• Who will be involved? What will they do? How often?• What is the timeframe of the project?• What materials and facilities will be required?• Please provide details about the topics, chemistry activities, or experiments.
Safety Considerations	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• How will the project participants ensure that appropriate safety precautions are taken?
Narrative Budget	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Please itemize and describe the expenditures you will make with this grant money if received. Typical award amounts are \$100-\$300. Please state whether or not your project would still be viable if you only receive partial funding from this grant. Also state sources of other funding if total project amount is greater than the requested funds from SC-ACS.

Deadline for submission September 1, award notifications will be made no later than September 7.

If a reward is received the final report form must be submitted by November 30 in order to be eligible for future awards.
