During this time the artists interacted with scientists in their laboratory environment and discussed important aspects of free radicals with key research staff and students.

The project has led to the creation of interpretative works that make up the INSIGHT RADICAL Exhibition, <u>www.insightradical.org</u>, The INSIGHT RADICAL Exhibition has visited the Griffin Gallery in London, the RAFT Gallery in Alice Springs, the MCLEMOI Gallery in Chippendale, Sydney, and is currently on show at the FutureSpace Gallery, Adelaide, as part of the Adelaide Fringe Festival.

Thanks to the generous support of John Newell Mazda, Alexandria, we have been able to invite Natalie O'Connor, one of the project artists, to give her perspective on the experience and explain the background to her artworks.
