Dear Parent/Caregiver,

It is so hard to believe that it is week seven of the last term of 2014.

Year 10 students have been busily writing their Final Examinations and the Bondi Campus is as quiet as I have ever known it, *Year 12* students being the only classes actually having lessons at the moment. Following their exams the *Year 10s* are involved in a week of Work Experience. This compulsory aspect of the *Year 10* curriculum has very positive outcomes for all students. They love the experience as it helps them realise which career path is best for them. This motivates students in their final two years of school. Should they not enjoy their chosen experience, this too is a positive outcome as they can at this early age reevaluate their options, change direction and not waste any time. Students have had the expectations of the work environment explained to them and we expect them to be proud ambassadors of the school during this week.

The Drama department has been wrapping up their academic year with students performing their solo and group pieces at lunchtime to very enthusiastic audiences. The enjoyment and confidence students gain from this programme is wonderful to witness. The *Year 7 to Year 9* students have been involved in a revision week prior to the start of their examinations on Friday. Students were issued with an examination booklet, which included the policies and procedures surrounding the exam process. These were explained to them in assembly and can be summarized as follows:

- ◆ Arrive at least 15 minutes before the examination to avoid panic.
- ◆ All equipment must be in a transparent zip lock bag/ pencil case.
- ◆ Lock mobile phones/ valuables in locker prior to examination.
- ◆ No talking, sharing information or using notes.
- ◆ Go to the toilet before the examination.

Study Tips shared with students included getting some exercise, eating well, getting enough sleep, taking regular breaks, making notes while reading their text, doing past papers, seeking tutorials and answering text book questions.

Students may go home directly after their examinations for that day end. They should avoid wasting time at the Junction after examinations and go directly home and start preparing for the next examination.

If students can only be picked up later from school, they are able to study in the Library, which is open and supervised until 4:30pm.

There has been much talk and enthusiasm around the "Gathering of the Tribes" cultural and sporting tour to Reddam Bearwood in London. If you have not "googled" Bearwood College yet, do so to understand the hype around this proposed trip. A parent information meeting will be held on Monday to gauge the actual interest.

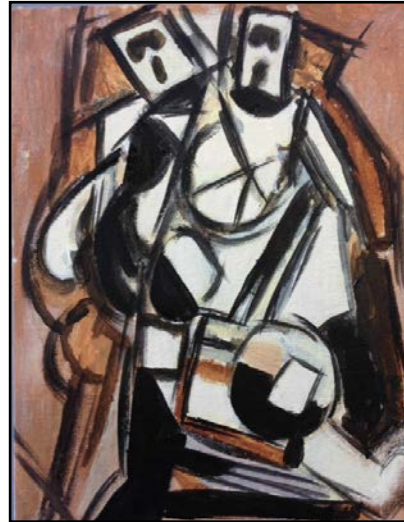
