SURN College and Career Readiness (CCR) Workshop
Monday August 5, 2013, Williamsburg, VA

In this daylong professional development workshop, English teachers will engage and explore in what they need to address the Virginia College and Career Readiness (CCR) English Performance Expectations. This experience is an introduction to resources developed as part of the 2011 Project Capstone and 2012 Senior English Academy and piloted in VA high school Senior English Seminar classes in a yearlong endeavor to integrate the CCR expectations into high school English courses.

- Participants will receive and explore **Over 30 English CCR lesson plans** that were developed, aligned to the Virginia CCR English Performance Expectations, and piloted in Virginia English classes.
- **De Fehrenbach**, Newport News Public Schools, Secondary English Supervisor, and **Kerrigan Mahoney**, former high school English teacher and current SURN English CCR Coordinator, will facilitate discussion and model strategies designed to **enhance student engagement** and learning with a **focus on argument, analysis, and reading fiction and nonfiction texts**.

Prior to the workshop, participants are expected to read an Alex award winning book that will be sent to them three weeks in advance of the workshop and spend approximately 1.5 hours engaged in an online interactive introduction to CCR in Virginia. Due to the advanced preparation and onsite engagement in the workshop, 10 contact hours will be offered for this session.
