#### IMPORTANT NOTE ABOUT BEFORE SCHOOL CARE

We found out this week that we may be able to offer before school care after all. Here is some information:

Community Education will likely be opening a state-licensed before-school program at Rich Pond Elementary in fall 2015. Programming would start at 6:30 a.m. Full-time before-school fees would be \$60 per month. Part-time before-school fees would be \$6 per day (cost-effective if child attends fewer than 10 days per month). If you need to drop your child before 7:45, you would be required to use Community Education. We still anticipate having staff available to supervise from around 7:45 until 8:00, when the doors will open to all regular bus and car riders. Please contact community education directly as soon as possible if you may be interested in this service.
