As a member of the council it will be your job to advise Into Film on a range of topics: our website, resources, communications, as well as the policy and delivery of our service. We want you to tell us what is and isn’t working and also give us ideas of changes we can make.

### As a member you will be expected to:

- Be a Youth Ambassador for Into Film
- Inform your club/school/youth club about Into Film
- Collect feedback about the Into Film programme from peers/film club members
- Keep up to date with the Into Film websites and provide feedback on content including videos and competitions
- Write reviews of films on the Into Film catalogue and post online
- Be prepared to attend Into Film events
- Attend regular meetings (approx. every 6 weeks, chaperoned by a parent/guardian). You will need to travel to these meetings but Into Film will cover the expenses.
- Commit to the post for one academic year running from September 2015 to June 2016.

- Practise in team work, planning, presentation and public speaking skills

### How to apply:

To apply to be a member of the Into Film Youth Advisory Council for 2015/16, please send us your answers to the questions overleaf, either by post or as a scanned version by email. Alternatively, you can produce a video application and send it to us via wetransfer. You must include the signed declaration along with the your application.

The deadline for applications is: **Mon 7<sup>th</sup> June 2015**

You may submit your application in written or video format.

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To send in a filmed application, visit [www.wetransfer.com](http://www.wetransfer.com) (you don’t need to subscribe). Click the ‘Add files’ button on the left hand side and select the clip you want to send, then click open. In the box underneath called ‘Friend’s email’, enter [yac@intofilm.org](mailto:yac@intofilm.org) and enter your own email address in the box below. In the final box you can write a short message to accompany your video application. Then click transfer to send the clip, this may take a few seconds.
