## What to expect...

We are introducing an interview format known as the 'Speed Interview' at the 2007 Career Connections. As part of this interview format, practitioners and candidates meet briefly (10 minutes) to form a first impression and to do some quick 'comparison shopping'. This format will allow for more students and employers to interact and allow students to explore job opportunities that they may not have under the traditional 60 minute first interview format. The Speed Interviews will be split into sections by type of practice (small, large, mixed) to ensure that practitioners and students are not wasting their time.

The event is expected to last two hours. This will be followed by time to conduct further in depth interviews with some of the candidates if desired.

Practitioners should know that not all students attending Career Connections will be looking for fulltime positions. Some will be looking for summer employment or externship opportunities which may potentially lead to a fulltime position after graduation. Others will be using the opportunity to explore their options and practice their interview skills.
