KCC Certificate of Achievement (CA) in Practical Nursing – Minimum Admissions Criteria: Applicants meeting the criteria below are considered qualified and will be considered for selection and admission.

1. Completion of **prerequisite courses** with a grade of “C” or higher;
2. A minimum **cumulative grade point ratio (CPR) of 2.5 or higher for the prerequisite general education courses and general support courses** in the nursing curriculum, all courses being completed with a grade of “C” or higher;
3. An **Assessment Technologies Institute – Test of Essential Academic Skills (ATI-TEAS) Exam for PN** taken with a percentile score of **65% or higher** (or equivalent scaled score or higher) with a 3-year expiration. **Effective October 1, 2013, an adjusted individual total score of 60% or higher (or equivalent scaled score or higher) will be considered for admission as part of a pilot study to be conducted by the KCC Nursing Department;**
4. A minimum **cumulative grade point ratio (GPR) of 2.0 for all college courses** taken at Kapi’olani Community College.
5. Courses taken for credit, or testing accepted by Kapi’olani Community College, will be accepted by the Nursing Department and will be assigned a grade of “C” for the application ranking process. Kapi’olani Community College reserves the right to make its own institutional decisions regarding specific transfer equivalencies;
6. Grades for courses taken for credit must be equivalent to a “C” or higher.

KCC Certificate of Achievement in Practical Nursing (PRCN)– Selection Criteria: Applicants with the highest scores will be admitted into the PRCN program. All qualified applicants will be ranked for admissions based on combined scores of the three areas below. In the event that several students achieve the same ranking, admission will be determined anonymously by random selection.

- ATI-TEAS exam percentile score (or equivalent scaled score);
- Grade point ratio (GPR) for prerequisite general education courses;
- Number of and grade point ratio (GPR) for co-requisite/support courses;
