IV. **Grading**

A. Homework—25%

- 1. Homework will be given. Homework completion is required
- 2. Reading logs must be completed and they will be checked for a homework grade each week.
- 3. Students are expected to read at least 30 mins each day.
- 4. Each student will receive a homework referral if the homework is incomplete. They homework referral and the assignment must be completed and then 20 points will be deducted. After 1 day, homework will not be accepted. Four homework referrals will result in MI's being given.
- 4. Wordly Wise will be implemented into the literature curriculum to improve vocabulary awareness. Wordly Wise units will count as homework grades.

B. Tests-75%

- 1. Tests are given at the end of each lit story.
- 2. All final copies of writing assignments are considered test grades.
- 3. Accelerated Reader points will be required and tests grades will be given based on meeting those AR goals. Students will have to meet their ½ AR goal by mid-quarter and their full AR goal by the end of each quarter.

V. Assignments

A. Lit Log

1. Each student will be required to keep a lit log showing that they are reading 30 mins a day. Parents will initial this log. A weekly homework grade will be given for a completed lit log.

B. Writing assignments

- 1. Students will work on many different types of writing.
- 2. Rough drafts will be required and count as homework grades and final, typed drafts will count as test grades.

C. Literature Units

- 1. Students will complete literature units in the new literature book and be tested on those units.
- 2. During the year the students will read selected novels as a class and complete required assignments and tests on those novels.

D. AR books and reading goals

- 1. All students will be given an AR goal that must be met each quarter. Meeting the $\frac{1}{2}$ AR goal and the full AR goal will each count as test grades.
- 2. Parents may log onto the AR system and get daily updates when their child has taken an AR test and to keep up with points earned.
