DESCRIPTION:

The Center for the Environment's Undergraduate Summer Research Fund provides financial support for student research projects related to the environment. The Fund offers two types of research experiences for students. In 2002 the Center established a competitive summer research grant program to support independent, original environmental research. Award amounts are normally between \$500-\$2,500, with a preference given to rising seniors seeking funds for senior honors thesis research. Students conducting research as part of an internship program are not eligible for these awards.

In 2007 the Center began a summer research assistantship program to encourage students to participate in summer research with Harvard faculty. The program offers funding for up to ten weeks of an undergraduate research assistant position at a competitive hourly wage. Each winter, the Center collects a wide variety of research assistant opportunities from its Faculty Associates and advertises them to students. To start the application process, students should first identify research positions of interest to them and contact the sponsoring faculty member directly to secure a brief letter of support.

To apply to either type of summer research opportunity, students should fill out this summer research fund application form. The Center will begin reviewing applications Tuesday, March 26, 2013.
