Wenatchee Valley College and Heritage University at Wenatchee are working collaboratively to provide a seamless transfer process between the two institutions by providing a dual admission program.

The dual admissions program enables students to complete their freshman and sophomore years at Wenatchee Valley College. **After a student earns a transferable associate degree (AA/DTA), he/she will continue as a student of Heritage University with junior level status.**

Dual admission will provide students accurate advising and scheduling information so they take specific courses at Wenatchee Valley College to facilitate the completion of a Bachelor of Arts in Education degree from Heritage in four years.

The Heritage University degree program is taught in the evenings and on weekends. You do not have to leave your local area to advance your education. Advisors for both WVC and Heritage work closely with students to assure that student needs are met.
