- The "root cause analysis" section will explore the method that is used to address a "system" or operational problem within the credit department, in order to get to the "root cause" of the problem. As part of this process, the credit function is broken down into steps or segments of the credit process.
- · Identifying the root cause of the problem
- This will be followed by the use of the "corrective action request" (CAR) form in order to correct or eliminate the "cause" and prevent the problem from recurring in the future.
