Department of Curriculum and Instruction Scholarships for INCOMING FRESHMEN & TRANSFER STUDENTS:



Materials submitted should include:

- 1. Completed application form provided in this document below (must be completed on a computer and then printed <u>handwritten applications will not be considered</u>).
- 2. Letter of Recommendation Form(s) attesting to the quality of the applicant's academic performance and promise as an educator, as specified. Form(s) are provided at the end of this document.
- 3. Other documents as specified by certain scholarship criteria, such as essays.
- 4. Transfers and currently enrolled students must provide most current transcript.

<u>Applications are due ON OR BEFORE APRIL 1, unless stated otherwise</u>. Application packages should be sent to the Chair of the Scholarship Committee, Department of Curriculum and Instruction, Horrabin Hall 40, Western Illinois University, 1 University Circle, Macomb, IL 61455.

SELECTION: The recipients will be selected by the Curriculum and Instruction Department Scholarship Committee with its recommendations provided to the Chairperson of the Department. Recipients will be announced in the spring and awarded at the WIU Foundation Scholars' Recognition Ceremony in the fall.

AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS AND CRITERIA:

<u>Maurice G. Kellogg Scholarship</u> (\$500 per year) Deadline to apply no later than November 15 of the student's senior year.

The applicant must provide a support letter from the high school counselor, dean, principal or administrator verifying ACT, class rank, graduation date, quality and quantity of high school academic and social performance, promise as an educator, and indication of financial need; AND a letter of recommendation from some other adult (non-relative), selected by the candidate, that has had an opportunity to evaluate the candidate's work habits, ambition, perseverance, pride in their performance, personality, character, and indication of financial need. Additional consideration may be given to students who have indicated an interest in and/or strong performance in science. The applicant must also:

- be an entering freshman intent to major in Elementary Education; and
- be a graduate of a high school in Hancock or Fulton County in Illinois (a graduate from any llinois high school may be considered if there is no qualified student from Hancock or Fulton County); and
- show evidence of involvement in high school and community activities (i.e. youth groups, academic clubs, scholastic teams, etc., especially in a leadership role); and
- have an ACT of 26 or above or an equivalent score on a like test or be in the upper 15% of their high school class; and
- demonstrate financial need.

Ethel Ray Scholarship (Up to \$850 per year)

The applicant must provide two letters of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor or school administrator; and

- be an entering freshman majoring in Elementary Education; and
- have an ACT score of 25; and
- be in the upper 25% of his/her graduating class.

Oliver and Mary Troyer Scholarship (Up to \$500)

The applicant must provide one letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor or school administrator; and

- be a freshman majoring in Elementary Education; and
- have and ACT score of 25 or higher; and
- have a high school GPA of 3.0 or better, and
- demonstrate financial need.

Maxine L. Robinson Scholarship (Up to \$450)

The applicant must provide one letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor or school administrator; and

- be an incoming freshman or transfer student majoring in Elementary Education; and
- if a freshman, must have an ACT score of 23 and be in upper 25% of graduating class; or, if a transfer student, must have a minimum of 30 semester hours with a GPA of 3.25 on a 4.0 scale; and
- if a freshman, be a resident of one of the 27 west-central Illinois counties served by WIU*; or, if a transfer student, be from any college or university; and
- show evidence of involvement in high school or community activities; and
- demonstrate financial need.

Opal Wedeberg Scholarship. (Up to \$275 per year)

The applicant must provide one letter of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor or school administrator; and

- be an incoming freshman or transfer student majoring in Elementary Education; and
- if a freshman, must have an ACT score of 23 and be in upper 25% of graduating class; or, if a transfer student, must have a minimum of 30 semester hours with a GPA of 3.25 on a 4.0 scale; and
- be a resident of one of the 27 west-central Illinois counties served by WIU*; and
- show evidence of involvement in high school or community activities; and
- demonstrate financial need.

*27 West-Central Illinois Counties served by WIU: Adams, Brown, Calhoun, Cass, Fulton, Greene, Hancock, Henderson, Henry, Jersey, Knox, Logan, Macoupin, Mason, McDonough, Menard, Mercer, Morgan, Peoria, Pike, Rock Island, Sangamon, Schuyler, Scott, Stark, Tazewell and Warren.
