All applications must be submitted by March 15, 2010 for travel that must occur between April 15 and June 30, 2010. Proposals will be reviewed and funding announced by April 7, 2010.

Funding Available:

The Graduate School will provide up to \$1000 toward the cost of presenting at a professional conference, and up to \$1500 toward the cost of attending a workshop/institute.

Application Process:

- 1. Completed application form with research mentor's signature
- 2. An itemized travel budget
- 3. A letter of support from your dissertation advisor or Director of Graduate Studies
- 4. Your academic CV
- 4a. For professional conferences:
 - 1) a copy of the letter accepting your presentation;
 - 2) a copy of the conference registration brochure/link to webpage; and
 - 3) a copy of your research abstract

- 4b. For workshops/institutes:
 - 1) a copy of your application;
 - 2) a copy of the workshop/institute registration brochure/link to webpage;
 - 3) a copy of your acceptance or indication from the organizers that you will likely be accepted
 - 4) a statement of purpose that indicates how this workshop will impact your research
