Transforming Education and Schools for English Learners (TESEL) is a federally-funded National Professional Development (NPD) project responding to a significant contemporary educational challenge: helping primary and secondary teachers develop improved skills and knowledge in supporting English Language Learners. It is expressly not the intent of the evaluators to assess *any* individual participant's work. Finally, all final reports will be available to interested participants.
