- 3. Two Letters of Recommendation (given to you in a sealed envelope or emailed directly to Max Maximov, MLNG FHSU). Reference letters, preferably by your advisor and other FHSU faculty members willing and able to make an informed yet impartial judgment about:

 your demonstrated qualities (both professional and personal) that are potentially relevant to
 - your demonstrated qualities (both professional and personal) that are potentially relevant to participating in this program;
 - the ways in which this experience would benefit you personally and / or professionally.
- 4. **Transcript(s)**: A copy of your current FHSU transcript and transcripts from all other higher education institutions attended. (**Note: minimum GPA requirement: 2.0 / 4.0**).
- 5. **(Optional)** You are free to attach **other supporting documentation** that you feel may be relevant for the screening committee to consider.
- **II. - NOTIFICATION TO THE APPLICANTS by SEPTEMBER 25, 2014 via email.
- First group meeting: SEPTEMBER 26, 2014 (details will be emailed).
- NON-REFUNDABLE DEPOSIT of \$250, payable in cash only, will be due at the first meeting. The deposit will be applied to booking the inland airfare (inside Chile) and, in part, to the "Chiloé Package."
- Full airfare payment due: 1st week of October 2014. (exact date tbd, current estimate: \$1,560).
- **REGISTRATION FOR THE COURSE**: upon receipt of the letter of acceptance.
- SCHOLARSHIPS will be made available to all eligible participating students.
- **PASSPORT**: All participants must have a passport (valid through May 2015)
- **INSURANCE**. All participants must provide proof of insurance. If a student's personal insurance does not provide coverage abroad, then it is the student's responsibility to buy international coverage.
