## **Teacher Education** Transition Point Requirements.

# Requirements prior to admission to Teacher Education

- Minimum 60 semester hours
- Successfully complete the Teacher Education Program Orientation Course ED 300.
- APTT (Alabama Prospective Teacher Test)—passing score required.\*
- Overall 2.5 GPA. d.
- Complete an application for admission to the TEP.
- Complete "Letter of Understanding." f.
- Fingerprinting (provide proof of background clearance from ALSDE).
- Candidate interview by program committee.
- Three Letters of Recommendation.

#### Admission to Preservice Teaching (Student Teaching)

- Minimum 2.5 GPA overall, JSU courses only, on all Professional Studies and all Teaching Field courses.
- b. Minimum grade of C is required on all Professional Studies and Teaching Field courses.
- PRAXIS II—passing score required.\*

# Minimum requirements for application for certification and graduation

- English Competency Exam (ECE)—passing score required.\*
- CBASE (College Base Examination).\*
- Complete an undergraduate application for degree.
- Complete all certification requirements (application for certification, required fees, and transcript request forms).
- Minimum 2.5 GPA overall, JSU courses only, and on all Professional Studies and all Teaching Field courses.
- Minimum grade of C is required on all Professional Studies and Teaching Field courses.
- Minimum 128 Total Hours.
- 52 hours 300/400 level.
- 64 Semester hours credit at a 4-year institution.
- 32 Semester hours credit at JSU.
