

General Education Core Curriculum Reporting Form

The General Education Core Curriculum (GECC) is a prescribed set of lower division general education courses. The GECC includes courses in the areas of Communications, Mathematics, Life and Physical Sciences, Humanities, Fine Arts and Social and Behavioral Sciences. All GECC courses are required to be completed with a grade of 'C' or higher and have been completed at a regionally accredited institution. Below you will find an explanation of which types of courses will satisfy each category and the total credit amounts required. Please place the corresponding information regarding courses you have previously completed with a grade of 'C' or higher in the *Course Prefix & Number* Column, the school where the course was completed in the *Institution* column, the *grade* received in the *Grade* column and the credit hours completed for the course in the *Hrs* column. All information must be substantiated by transcripts submitted during the admission process. Please remember to sign and date the bottom of the GECC form before submitting. Completed form should be submitted to GECC@govst.edu.

Three courses are required in the Communications category. The courses must be a Composition I and II course and a Speech or Oral Communications. Remedial courses will not satisfy this requirement.

Mathematics (1 course; 3 semester hours)

One course is required in the Mathematics category. Examples of math courses that will satisfy the requirement are as follows: College Algebra or any Math course with an IAI code. Remedial courses will not satisfy this requirement.

Sciences (2 courses; 7 semester hours)

Two courses are required in the Sciences category. One course must be a Life Science course. Examples of Life Science courses are as follows: Biology or Natural Sciences. One course must be a Physical Science. Examples of Physical Science courses are as follows: Astronomy, Chemistry, Physical Geography, Physical Science or Physics. One course must contain a lab.

Humanities/Fine Arts (3 courses; 9 semester hours)

Three courses are required in the Humanities/Fine Arts category. One course must be a Humanities. Examples of Humanities courses are as follows: Culture Studies, Ethics, Foreign Language, Literature, Poetry, Philosophy, Sign Language or Theology. Once course must be a Fine Arts. Examples of Fine Arts courses are as follows: Art Appreciation, Art History, Music Appreciation, or Theatre Appreciation; these must be theory courses not practical application classes. The third course can be either a Humanities or Fine Arts.

Social and Behavioral Sciences (3 courses; 9 semester hours)

Three courses are required in the Social and Behavioral category. Examples of Social and Behavioral Science courses are as follows: Anthropology, Criminal Justice, Economics, Gender Studies, History, Government, Psychology, Sociology or Social Studies. Courses must be completed in two separate disciplines (cannot be three Psychology courses).
