Other Important Information:

- Students should complete a VA online application (VONAPP) by visiting VA.GOV.
- The VA Certifying Official needs the FORM DD214 Certificate of Release or Discharge from Active Duty as well as the Certificate of Eligibility Letter from the VA for the student's file.
- Student should email the VA official whenever they register or change their schedule.
- Only CH 31 students should be allowed to order textbook via voucher. All others must have financial aid to cover books.
