

**Renewal Transfer Agreement
University of California, Irvine Extension and the
University of Wisconsin-Platteville
Master of Science in Project Management**

Completion of the University of California, Irvine Extension (UC Irvine Extension) Certificate in Project Management equates to 12 graduate credits in the UW-Platteville Master of Science in Project Management program, under the following stipulations:

- 1) The UC Irvine Extension certificate in project management program (<http://unex.uci.edu/uwp>) must be completed before student is admitted to the M.S. in Project Management program at UW-Platteville. The UC Irvine Extension certificate in project management program must also be completed within 7 years prior to admission at UW-Platteville.
- 2) A grade of "B" or better must be earned in all coursework from the UC-Irvine certificate program to be eligible for transfer into the UW-Platteville M.S. in Project Management program. The required certificate courses (14.5 credits) and any two electives totaling 17.5 quarter credits earns the certificate, and is eligible for transfer to UW-Platteville's MS Project Management program upon admission thereto. See **attachment A** for the certificate requirements, including electives. See **attachment B** for substitute and retired courses, including special topics classes not listed in the course catalogs.
- 3) Completion of the UC-Irvine Certificate in Project Management (17.5 quarter credits), equates to 12 graduate credits in the UW-Platteville M.S. in Project Management program, in the following manner:

<u>UW-Platteville Courses</u>	<u>Semester Credits</u>
a. PM 701 Project Management Techniques 1	3 credits
b. PM 702 Project Management Techniques 2	3 credits
c. Project Management Electives	6 credits
TOTAL	12 credits

- 4) Under this agreement, both parties may advertise this articulation agreement to their students, prospective students and alumni through print, online and interactive marketing materials such as fliers, websites and other advertisements, subject to the guidelines and restrictions further described in this section.
 - a. Each party shall provide the other with a high-resolution logo file and hereby grants the other license to use the name and/or logo for these limited purposes.
 - b. Use of UC Irvine Extension name: In all communications as described above, the entity name shall be "UC Irvine Extension" or "University of California, Irvine Extension". It is not appropriate to use other variations of the University's name, such as "University of California" or "UC Irvine".
 - c. Prior written approval for any uses of the UC Irvine Extension name or logo beyond those explicitly stated above must be obtained from the UC Irvine Extension director of marketing or designee.
 - d. Prior written approval must be obtained by the issuing party in advance of issuance of press release(s) featuring the name and/or logo of the other party.

This agreement will continue to be reviewed every three years to determine whether it is achieving its purpose and continuing to meet our institutions' needs. Please note that either party has the right to terminate this agreement upon 30 days notice. Any cancellation of this agreement shall provide for students active, at that time of cancellation, to complete any program in progress at that time.
