## **ABOUT**

The Belmont Summer Vocal Arts Intensive is a week-long immersive experience in solo and choral singing in a variety of styles. Students entering grades 9-12 will engage in rehearsals, masterclasses, and performances with the outstanding artistic faculty at Belmont University. The Summer Vocal Arts Intensive provides a unique opportunity to experience high level artistry in both classical and commercial singing. This residential camp takes place on Belmont University's beautiful campus in downtown Nashville, TN.

## **DAILY SCHEDULE**

Each day, students will participate in mass choir rehearsals, electives, small ensembles, master classes, and social experiences. The mass choir will rehearse and perform a final concert of traditional and contemporary choral music. Small ensemble opportunities include Chamber Choir, Jazz Choir, A Capella Choir, and Musical Theatre ensemble. Master classes will provide solo vocal lessons in a group setting – choose from classical, commercial, or integrative tracks. Elective classes will offer opportunities to explore Choral Conducting, Diction for Singers, GarageBand, and more. Evening activities include a mix of social activities (bowling, movies!) and recitals (faculty and campers).

## **HOUSING AND MEALS**

Students will be housed in Belmont University dormitories. While in the dormitories, participants are under the careful supervision of the camp staff, and security is a priority. All meals are served in the Johnson Center Dining Hall, beginning with dinner on Sunday, June 26 and ending with breakfast on Saturday, July 2.

## **ELIGIBILITY**

The camp is open to all woodwind, brass, and percussion students who will enter grades 9-12 in the upcoming fall semester. Students must have had prior experience on their instrument and demonstrate an acceptable level of performance ability suited for a week of intensive study and performance.

A discount of \$50 is granted to students who have participated in top regional/area honor choir or mid-state (Region/Area Choir, or All Mid-State/All-West/All-State East). A \$100 discount is available to students who have placed in all-state choir for their state. Only one discount will apply. Two or more siblings from the same family qualify for a tuition discount of \$25 per student.

The cost for resident campers includes tuition, lodging, all meals, activities, and a camp t-shirt. The cost for commuter campers includes tuition, lunch and dinner (breakfast not included), activities, and a camp t-shirt.

## **ELIGIBILITY AND AUDITIONS**

The Belmont Summer Vocal Arts Intensive is open to students entering grades 9-12 in the Fall of 2016.

No auditions are necessary for general camp participation. Students wishing to sing in the Chamber Choir or Jazz Choir small ensembles will audition on Sunday afternoon during registration. Audition materials will be placed on the website in May under the 'General Information' link.
