Residency requirement:

A residency requirement of 32 semester hours is required to graduate from Brenau University with a dance education major. This includes a major residency of 21 semester hours.

Note: This program plan is not an official document. It is a tool to assist the student and adviser in schedule planning.

Technique:

Students must take a total of 16 hours of technique. Of those hours, a minimum of 4 credits each of ballet, modern, and jazz dance is required. Students must be enrolled in at least one technique class per semester with the exception of the semester a student is enrolled in student teaching. Prior to graduation students must attain and enroll in a 300 level or higher technique class in at least two genres of ballet, modern, or jazz dance.

After completing liberal education and major requirements, if the total number of hours on the student's transcript is not at 125, then the student must take enough general elective hours to reach a cumulative total of 125 hours. If a course is repeated, it is the student's responsibility to contact the Registrar's Office to adjust the earned hours on their transcript so that they are not short hours at graduation. Due to placement, a student may graduate with more than 125 semester hours.
