# **HONORS**

Undergraduate students will receive honors at graduation for work completed through their previous semester, however the student's permanent record will reflect the overall GPA through the final semester. Latin honors are determined on the basis of the cumulative grade point average (GPA) of all coursework completed at Concordia University and all other colleges and universities attended. Students who complete the requisite number of Honors courses and/or hours will receive recognition at graduation as either Honors Associate or Honors Scholar.

# REGALIA - \$55 + Postage and Handling

Graduates will be responsible for ordering and paying for their own regalia (cap, gown, stole and tassel). Graduates will be informed via email when to order regalia.

### **Exit Loan Counseling**
