

Campus Housing

A limited number of rooms in Loeber Hall will be available for the Reunion. Please note that these rooms are on the second floor, and no elevator is available. The rate is \$20 per person, with two people per room. These rooms are air-conditioned, dorm-style accommodations. TV and private bathrooms are not available in these rooms. There is one men's and one women's bathroom down the hall, with several showers and washbasins in each. Most rooms are equipped with two single beds, desks, dressers and closets. Bed linens and towels are provided. To request a room on campus, please complete the Campus Housing portion of the registration form. Rooms will be assigned in the order the forms are received. The Seminary reserves the right to place a second person in a room where both beds are not reserved.
