A BILL TO APPLY FULL-TIME STATUS DEFINE BY THE HPU GUIDELINES AND REQUIREMENTS TO THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION CONSTITUTION

WHEREAS, Section 6. Powers, responsibilities, and general parameters part N of HPU SGA's constitution states that the, "Senate may establish additional Student Government Association organizations, non-officer positions, and officer positions subject to the Student Body President";

WHEREAS, the wording of full time status in the Student Government Association's Constitution contradicts the presiding HPU Guidelines and Requirements;

WHEREAS, the issue must be corrected to allow the Student Government Association's Constitution to properly represent the HPU Guidelines and Requirements.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE STUDENT SENATE OF HAWAI'I PACIFIC UNIVERSTIY THAT:

The SGA Constitution be amended under Article II Section 1-k.

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED THAT:

The following content be amended under Article II Section 1-k;

Section 1. Composition and qualifications of membership of the Senate.

a. Members of the Senate shall have and maintain a HPU grade point average (GPA) of at least 2.5, with temporary exception to students who do not yet have an established HPU GPA. Members of the Senate shall be taking no less than twelve (12) HPU credits during the fall and spring semesters of the session in which their term of office commenced Members of the senate must have full-time status according to the HPU guidelines and requirements.
