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## — ABOUT THE COACH —



Chris Leonardi just finished his first season as the MMC head men's soccer coach where he led the RedHawks to the SSAC Conference Championship title game and a 9-6-3 record. The previous 2 seasons, Leonardi was the assistant at MMC where, in 2013 he helped lead the RedHawks to a record-breaking 19-2-2 season that culminated in the program's first-ever NAIA men's national championship in school history.

Prior to joining MMC, Leonardi was the boys and girls soccer coach at the University School of Jackson.

With the girls, Leonardi tallied a 227-57-16 overall record and won 2 state titles in 2010 & 2011. In 13 years, the girls made 3 championship appearances, 5 final four appearances, 8 state tournament appearances, and won 9 region titles and 5 district titles. Leonardi was voted NSCAA Regional Coach of the year (Private/parochial, high school girls) in 2011.

With the boys, Leonardi tallied a 204-78-17 overall record. In 12 years, the boys made 2 final four appearances, 4 state tournament appearances, and won 6 region titles, and 8 district titles.

Leonardi is part of the TN ODP staff, and a coaching instructor for Tennessee State Soccer Association.

Leonardi currently holds the United States Soccer Federation (USSF) "A" License, the National Soccer Coaches Association of America (NSCAA) Premier Diploma, and the NSCAA Goalkeeping Level 1 License.

A 1998 graduate of Lambuth University in Jackson, Tennessee, he earned a B.S in Physical Education and Health. During his playing career with the Eagles, Lambuth captured one TCAC Conference Championship and two Mid-South Conference Championships.

Hailing from Nice, France, Leonardi moved to the United States at the age of 16 to attend high school in Jackson, Tennessee.
