The application fee and form do not guarantee that a student will perform in the master classes. The performers for master classes will be chosen by the clinicians and by their age group categories. No repertoire change will be allowed after participants have been chosen.

All applicants are required to attend all concerts/events during the festival weekend and perform in the final festival concert on Sunday, September 9th. Please prepare standard solo classical piano repertoire, i.e. no duets, concertos, hymn arrangements, etc...
