Portfolio Review is designed to allow the art faculty to see the range of art majors' work and to provide an opportunity to talk about students' choices and decisions for the junior and senior years in the major.

Works must be displayed in Olin 323 by 12:00 p.m. on Portfolio Day.

Students may choose to meet with faculty members on Portfolio Day, after they review the portfolios, but are not required to do so; a sign-up sheet will be provided to arrange meeting times.

A New Majors Show will be set up in the Corridor Gallery after Portfolio Day in the spring semester; several works from each student's portfolio will be chosen to display in the show. All other student works may be picked up from Olin 323 after 5:00 on Portfolio Day.

Students who do not already have an art advisor will be assigned one after Portfolio Day. You will receive notification of the change of advisor both through an email finalizing your program declaration and through a letter from the art faculty.
