CMA CGM ST PETERSBURG SHUTTLE A ready for citrus season

CMA CGM is pleased to announce the tuning of <u>ST PETERSBURG</u> <u>SHUTTLE SERVICE A</u>'s rotation so as to prepare the opening of the citrus season from Morocco.

As from November 2013, the rotation of French Baltic Line will be adapted as follows: Zeebrugge - Antwerp - **Dunkirk** - St Petersburg (First Container Terminal Area 3) - St Petersburg (Petrolesport) - Zeebrugge.

CMA CGM extends its coverage of **Algeria** by adding a call at **Djen Djen**. Effective October 2013, the **MALTA-BEJAIA** feeder adds a weekly call at Djen Djen, along the following rotation: Malta - Djen Djen - Bejaia -Malta, with a maiden call at Djen Djen scheduled on October 28th, 2013.

The main target of this additional call is to **improve the coverage of Eastern Algeria**, avoiding at the same time the congestion troubles faced in some Algerian ports. In this perspective, **Djen Djen is ideally located** at equal distance between Algiers/Bejaia and Skikda/Annaba.

Ocean Freight amendments

In order to maintain the high level of reliability and efficiency of services as well as to continue offering global scope to its customers, CMA CGM will implement the following **Rate Restorations Program**:

 \gg From Asia (including Japan, South East Asia and Bangladesh) to North Europe (including UK and the full range from Portugal to Russia):

 US\$ 750 per TEU (dry, OOG's, paying empties, break-bulk and reefer cargo)

Effective November 1st, 2013 (on board date).

➢ From Asia (including Japan, South East Asia and Bangladesh) to Mediterranean (including West Med, Adriatic, East Med, Black Sea and North Africa):

 US\$ 750 per TEU (dry, OOG's, paying empties, break-bulk and reefer cargo)

Effective November 1st, 2013 (B/L date).

➢ From Mediterranean (including West Med, Adriatic, East Med and Black Sea) to Asia (including Far East, Middle East Gulf, India and Pakistan):

US\$ 100 per container (all cargo)

Effective November 1st, 2013 (B/L date).

> From Asia (including Japan, South East Asia and Bangladesh) to East Africa:

US\$ 200 per TEU (dry, reefer, OOG's and break-bulk)

Effective November 1st, 2013 (B/L date).

Myanmar Compliance Booking Procedure

CMA CGM wishes to inform its customers about two changes regarding the **Myanmar booking procedure**. These two amendments are effective immediately:

• No more LOI* requested for shipment to/from Myanmar,

• Specific rules for 4 Specially Designated Nationals Banks under OFAC General License, allowing transactions with these entities under conditions to be checked with your local agent:

- Asia Green Development Bank,
- Ayeyarwady Bank,
- Myanma Economic Bank, and
- Myanma Investment and Commercial Bank.

Europe ban on Faeroe Islands herring stock

CMA CGM wishes to inform and alert its customers about a regulation that European Union has decided on August 20th, 2013.

As per Commission Regulation (EU) N° 793/2013, The Faeroe Islands shall be identified as a country allowing non-sustainable fishing of the Atlanto-Scandian herring stock and so it shall be **prohibited to introduce into the territory of the European Union**, including for transhipment purposes at ports, fish or fishery products made of, or containing Atlanto-Scandian herring (Clupea Harengus) or mackerel (Scomber scombus) - caught under the control of the Faeroe Islands.
