## INSTRUCTIONS

Submit the completed application, payment in the form of a personal check, money order or cashier's check, and any required attachments to your local County Tax Assessor-Collector's office. **Do not mail cash.** The license plate fee is \$5.30 per year.

NOTE: The registration year for this type of license plate expires on March 31st of each year.

If you place your order by mail, please contact your County Tax Assessor-Collector's office in two weeks to verify your plate is ready for issuance.

Specialty plate fees will not be refunded once application is submitted. Contact your County Tax Assessor-Collector if you have any questions.
