

## WCC Sparks Campus Foundation 2016 Spring Scholarships

- 1. Eufaula/Barbour Co. Chamber Existing Industries Scholarship: Two (2) \$833.33 scholarships will be awarded to an Alabama resident enrolled in one of the following programs: Engineering Graphics and Animation, Welding Technology, Applied Engineering Technology, Business and Office Information Processing Concentrations, or Computer Information Science Concentrations. The applicant must demonstrate a financial need. (Renewable for two terms)
- 2. **Humminbird Scholarship:** Two (2) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to students enrolled in Industrial Maintenance Technology and/or Computer Information Science.
- **3. Pitts Trailers Scholarship:** A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a student enrolled in the Welding program.
- 4. The Sparks Campus Foundation Directors' Scholarship: A \$750 scholarship will be awarded to a student meeting the scholarship criteria. (*Renewable one term*)
- 5. **Spring 2016 General Scholarship:** Five (5) \$750 scholarships will be awarded to students who meet the scholarship criteria.
- Recipient <u>must</u> register for and maintain a full academic load (12 semester hours) or one that is consistent with the chosen program of study, <u>must</u> have a high school diploma or GED, <u>must</u> maintain at least a 2.5 GPA, and meet other specified scholarship criteria.
- Only students enrolled on the Sparks Campus are eligible for scholarships through the Sparks Foundation unless otherwise noted.
- Students must complete the FASFA as part of the application process.
