IDAHO BIG GAME RECORDS ENTRY FORM

The Idaho Big Game Records are maintained by the Idaho Department of Fish and Game (IDFG) to recognize trophy wild big game animals in Idaho. Game farm animals are not accepted.

The records are updated annually in May. To enter a trophy into the Idaho records, complete and submit this form. *The deadline for submission to be included in the annual update is April 1.*

Trophies must be measured by a designated IDFG employee or an official measurer of the Boone and Crockett Club or Pope and Young Club. Contact any IDFG office for a list of local measurers. Prior to an official measurement, the animal's skull, antlers or horns must be air dried (not frozen) for at least 60 days from the date of harvest.

The minimum scores for entry into the Idaho Big Game Records are the same for archery, rifle, muzzleloader and "picked-up" entries.
