**Who May Apply?** All 4-12<sup>th</sup> grade students are eligible to participate in the poetry contest.

- Participants must be enrolled in a Kentucky school.

- Entries must be **200 words or less** on standard 8-1/2" x 11" white paper with 1" margins, double spaced, and in no creative font (Arial and or/New Times Roman are recommended).
- Videos, films, drawings, etc. will not be accepted.

**Awards:** Contest winners will receive a personalized plaque. **Note:** First, second and third place winners will be selected in each school grade from 4-12<sup>th</sup>.

**EXTENDED Deadline:** Entries <u>must be received</u> (not postmarked) in the Governor's Office of Minority Empowerment no later than close of business on Monday, November 30, 2015.
