©Member participated only in a limited number of club meetings (5 or over) - LESS THAN FIVE CANNOT EXHIBIT AT FAIR.

<sup>©</sup>Member did little of the work with their project.

<sup>©</sup>Member showed no interest in 4-H or was a problem in the club.
